Serpentine Wildlife Management Area

During the fall and winter months, thousands of birds shelter in this area where there is open water and a good, natural food supply. The Serpentine Wildlife Management Area, better known as Serpentine Fen, lies in a triangle between Highway 99, King George Boulevard and the Serpentine River. This area is managed by Ducks Unlimited Canada and is home to more than 130 different species of birds, and there are three observation towers for better viewing.

When walking along the dyke, keep your eyes on the water as harbour seals have been known to swim up the channel from Boundary Bay.



Keep dogs on leash at all times; please clean up after your dog.



Leave all plants and animals for others to enjoy. Do not feed birds and wildlife.
