Reminder

- The Consultant is to highlight on the water drawing(s) in bold letters at the location of the tie-in point(s) information with reference to the contractor supplying all the specific tie-in materials.
- Where Fire lines and Domestic Services are being installed by City water crews; the City will supply the materials at the developer's cost. However, there may be some instances where the consultant and the City have agreed on the materials being supplied for a specific project by the developer's contractor.

Pre-Construction Meeting

The Consultant shall bring one water design drawing to the pre-construction meeting for the City Inspector.
